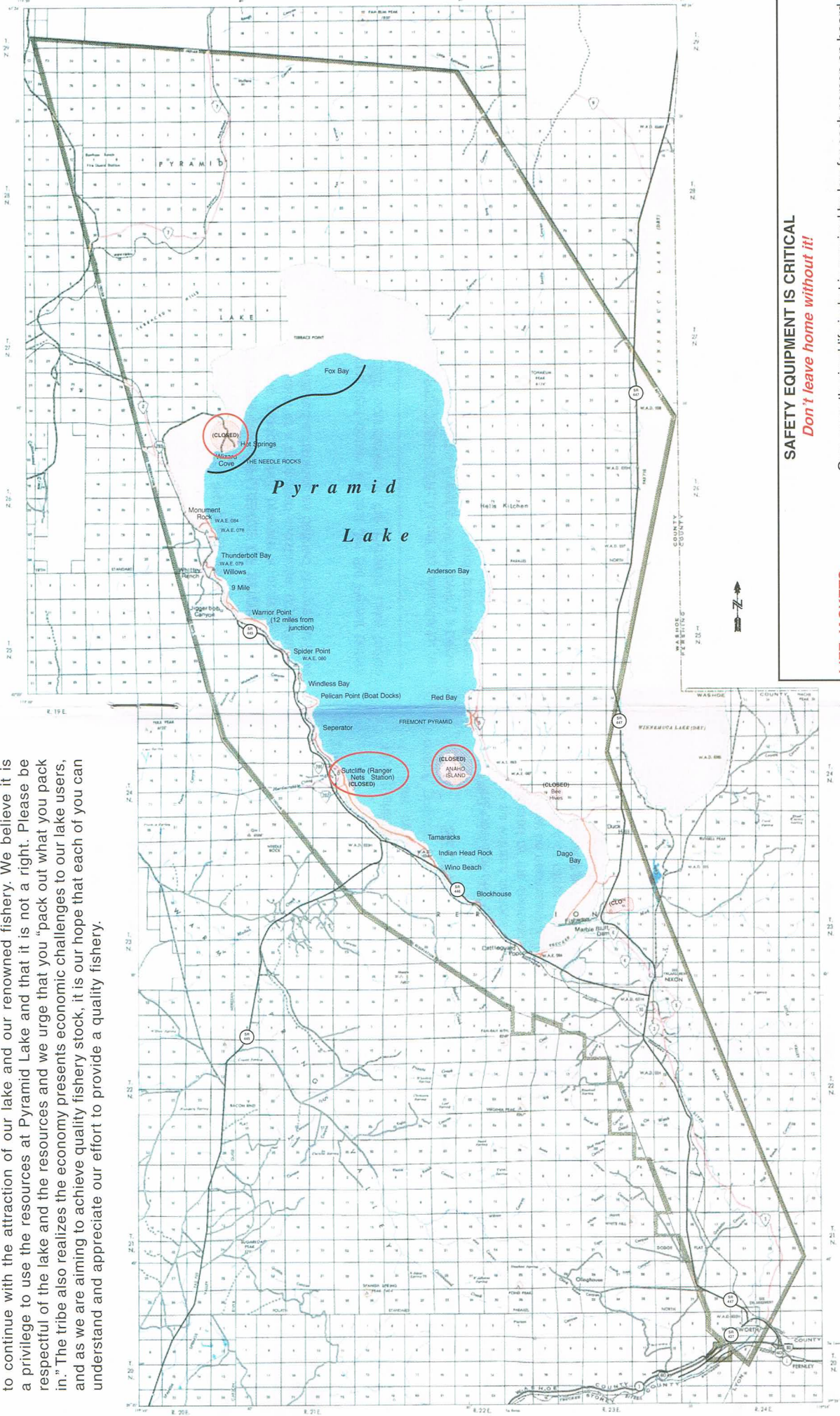

**SAFETY EQUIPMENT IS CRITICAL**  
*Don't leave home without it!*

- One correctly sized life jacket is required by law for each person on board. Children under the age of 13 **must** wear it.
- Any boat 16 feet or longer must carry a type IV throwable cushion or ring.
- Any boat that uses gasoline must carry one, and it must be charged.
- Every boat must be properly muffled.
- If you ski or dive you need to display the appropriate signal flag.
- All boats must carry a horn, whistle or other sound producing device. If the boat breaks down, an anchor is essential for protecting yourself and your boat, although not legally required.
- Though not required, signal flares and flags can attract attention if the need arises.
